HELPING YOUR CHILD

- Talk about all the things happening in Nursery. (pictures on Seesaw/school website may help this.)

E.g. “What was in the water today?”

What was the story about today?

Tell me about your painting.

- point out green objects during play or while on an outing.
- Read bedtime stories about our theme.
- Encourage your child to repeat Nursery rhymes/songs sung in nursery at home. (They are an important part of language development and pre-reading skills.)

- It has been great getting to know your little ones over these initial days. They are making pleasing progress in settling into the nursery routines and rules.
- To assist in the “settling-in” process can you please bring in a family photograph for our “People Who Love Us” board. This board stays up all year and it is a focus of attention and language development for all the children.
